



## THE THIRD DAY-Show 208: Reading the Map 8 “Five Months of Torment”

**Rev 9:5** And to them it was given that they should not kill them, but that they should be tormented five months: and their torment was as the torment of a scorpion, when he striketh a man.

**Rev 9:10** And they had tails like unto scorpions, and there were stings in their tails: and their power was to hurt men five months.

**Luke 1:24-26** And after those days his wife Elisabeth conceived, and hid herself five months, saying, **25** Thus hath the Lord dealt with me in the days wherein he looked on me, to take away my reproach among men. **26** And in the sixth month the angel Gabriel was sent from God unto a city of Galilee, named Nazareth,

**Luke 1:36** And, behold, thy cousin Elisabeth, she hath also conceived a son in her old age: and this is the sixth month with her, who was called barren.

**Elisabeth** - 1665 Elisabet *el-ee-sab'-et* of Hebrew origin (472); Elisabet, an Israelitess:-- Elisabeth.

**0472** 'Eliysheba *el-ee-sheh'-bah* from 410 and 7651 (in the sense of 7650); God of (the) oath...

**7651** sheba *sheh'-bah* from 7650; a primitive cardinal number; seven (as the sacred full one); also (adverbially) seven times

**7650** shaba *shaw-bah'* a primitive root; propr. to be complete, but used only as a denominative from 7651; to seven oneself, i.e. swear (as if by repeating a declaration seven times)...

**Luke 1:24** And after those days his wife Elisabeth conceived, ...

**4815** sullambano *sool-lam-ban'-o* from 4862 and 2983; to clasp, i.e. seize (arrest, capture); specially, to conceive (literally or figuratively); by implication, to aid:--catch, conceive, help, take.

**...and hid herself five months,**

**Hid** 4032 perikrupto *per-ee-kroop'-to* from 4012 and 2928; to conceal all around, i.e. entirely:--hide.

**2928** *krupto kroop'*-to a primary verb; to conceal (properly, by covering):--hide (self), keep secret, secret(-ly).

**Isa 42:22** But this is a people robbed and spoiled; they are all of them snared in holes, and they are hid in prison houses: they are for a prey, and none delivereth; for a spoil, and none saith, Restore.

**Na 3:11** Thou also shalt be drunken: thou shalt be hid, thou also shalt seek strength because of the enemy.

**Zep 2:3** Seek ye the LORD, all ye meek of the earth, which have wrought his judgment; seek righteousness, seek meekness: it may be ye shall be hid in the day of the LORD'S anger.

**Meek** 6035`*anav aw-nawv'* from 6031; depressed (figuratively), in mind (gentle) or circumstances (needy, especially saintly):--humble, lowly, meek, poorfrom

**6031**; depressed, in mind or circumstances...afflicted, humble, lowly, needy, poor.

**Mr 4:22** For there is nothing hid, which shall not be manifested; neither was any thing kept secret, but that it should come abroad.

**Romans 8:19 -23** For the earnest expectation of the creature waiteth for the manifestation of the sons of God. **20** For the creature was made subject to vanity, not willingly, but by reason of him who hath subjected the same in hope, **21** Because the creature itself also shall be delivered from the bondage of corruption into the glorious liberty of the children of God. **22** For we know that the whole creation groaneth and travaileth in pain together until now. **23** And not only they, but ourselves also, which have the firstfruits of the Spirit, even we ourselves groan within ourselves, waiting for the adoption, to wit, the redemption of our body.

**Abroad** 5318 *phaneros fan-er-os'* from 5316; shining, i.e. apparent (literally or figuratively)

**5316** *phaino fah'-ee-no* prolongation for the base of 5457; to lighten (shine)...

**Mt 13:43** Then shall the righteous shine forth as the sun in the kingdom of their Father. Who hath ears to hear, let him hear.

The 144,000 are a city set on a hill. **Mt 5:14** Ye are the light of the world. A city that is set on an hill cannot be hid.
